

**Fifty-Seventh Report of the TSCA Interagency Testing Committee to the Administrator,
U.S. Environmental Protection Agency**

In this 57th Interagency Testing Committee (ITC) Report to the Administrator of EPA, there are no changes to the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) Section 4(e) *Priority Testing List* published in the 56th ITC Report in the **Federal Register** of October 24, 2005 (70 FR 61520 (FRL-7739-9) (<http://www.epa.gov/fedrgstr/EPA-TOX/2005/October/Day-24/t21197.htm>)). As stated in the 56th ITC Report, it was the ITC's intention to provide in this 57th ITC Report a data-availability study of the high production volume (HPV) chemicals in the 2002 Inventory Update Rule (IUR). The study of the HPV chemicals in the 2002 IUR may be made available after the ITC has had an opportunity to review comments received on the study of the HPV chemicals described in the 56th ITC Report. In addition, the ITC needs additional time to review information submitted from the International Tungsten Industry Association, the Indium Corporation of America, and the Vanadium Producers and Reclaimers Association as well as data on tungsten, indium, and vanadium compounds submitted in response to TSCA section 8(a) Preliminary Assessment Information Reporting (PAIR) rules.
